1. Backyard Biologist

October 5 and 6

Let's discover the plants and animals that call our backyards home. We'll explore nearby Country Park in search of native salamanders, birds, plants and more. Please wear closed-toed shoes for this outdoor adventure class.

2. Amazing Me

October 12 and 13

Get ready for some heart-pumping fun as you get the "inside scoop" on your amazing body. Bone up on your skeleton and learn how to eat healthy. Examine some cool x-rays and discover how your body is really an amazing machine.

October 19 and 20

Our bodies need the right nutrition to function properly. Let's explore what our bodies need to stay healthy and enjoy some healthy snacks. We'll also visit the zoo commissary to discover who slurps up a smoothie and who eats 8 pounds of fruits & veggies each day.
