- 1. Weather Wonders** **December 1 and 2**

- 2. Desert Dwellers** **December 8 and 9**
Let's warm up as we learn about animals of the desert. We'll explore the deserts of the world and try our hand at some sand art. We'll also meet an animal who calls this dry habitat home.
- 3. Star Struck** **December 15 and 16**
Make your way to the Milky Way where the stars hang out! From comets to constellations, we'll check out the amazing things that light up our night sky.
- 4. Winter Wonderland** **January 5 and 6**
Join us we explore all things winter. From investigating snow and ice to animals that hibernate, this class will be a chillin' good time. We'll make a snow craft and meet an animal that has the perfect winter outfit.
